PREPARATION, IMPORTANT!!

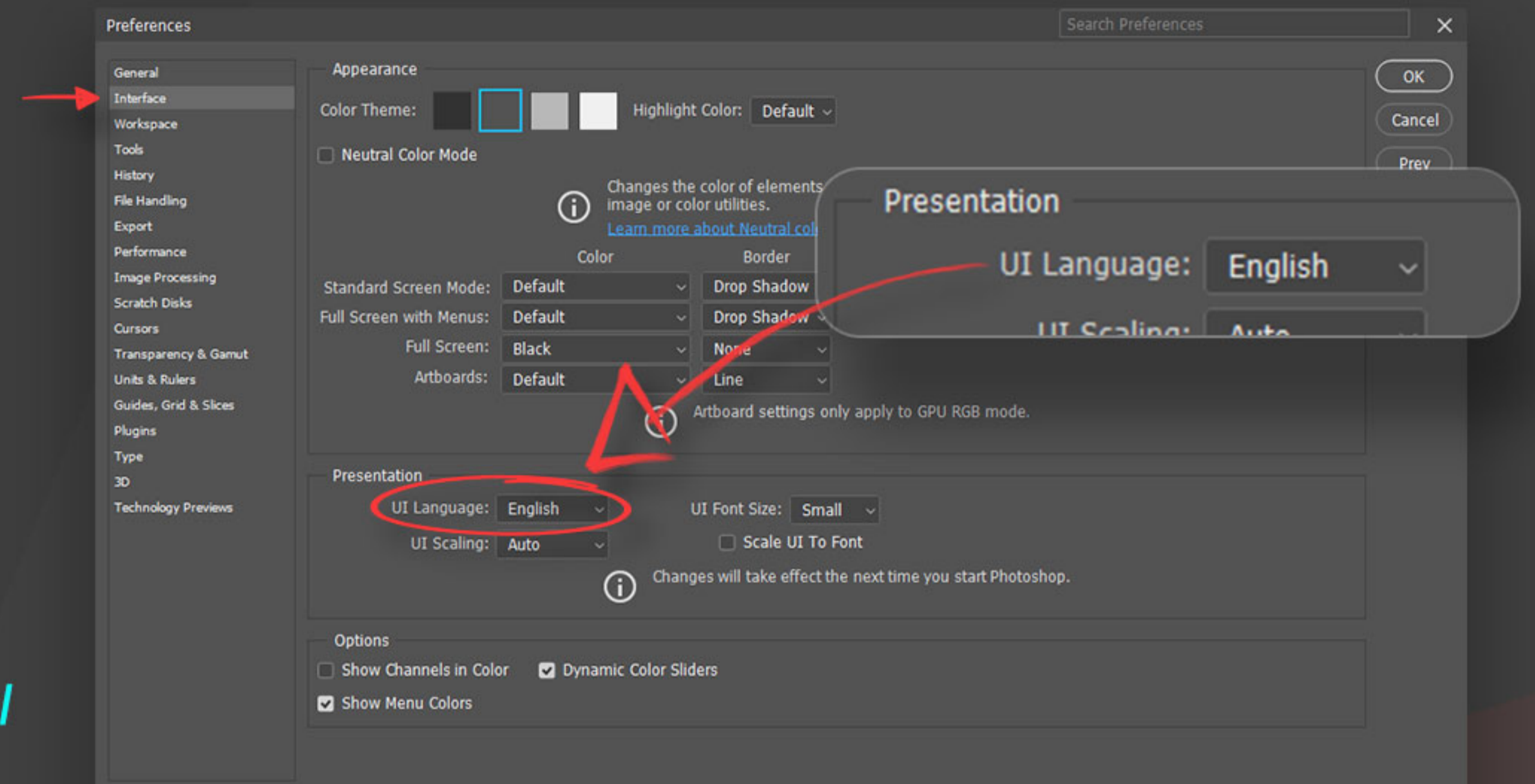
Please check and make it sure before you use the Photoshop Action

1. Make sure you are running the **English version of Photoshop**. If you are not using the English version of Photoshop, you can always change it to English and then back again to your native language using this step below.

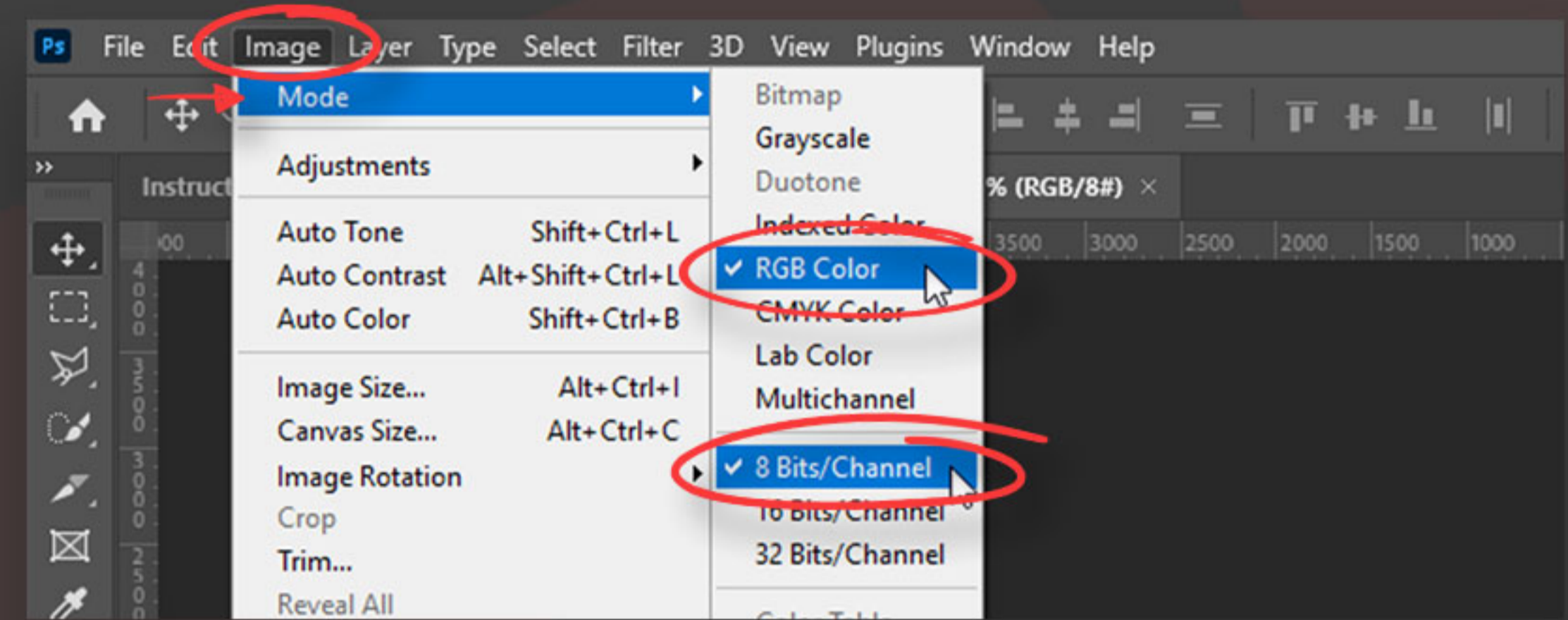

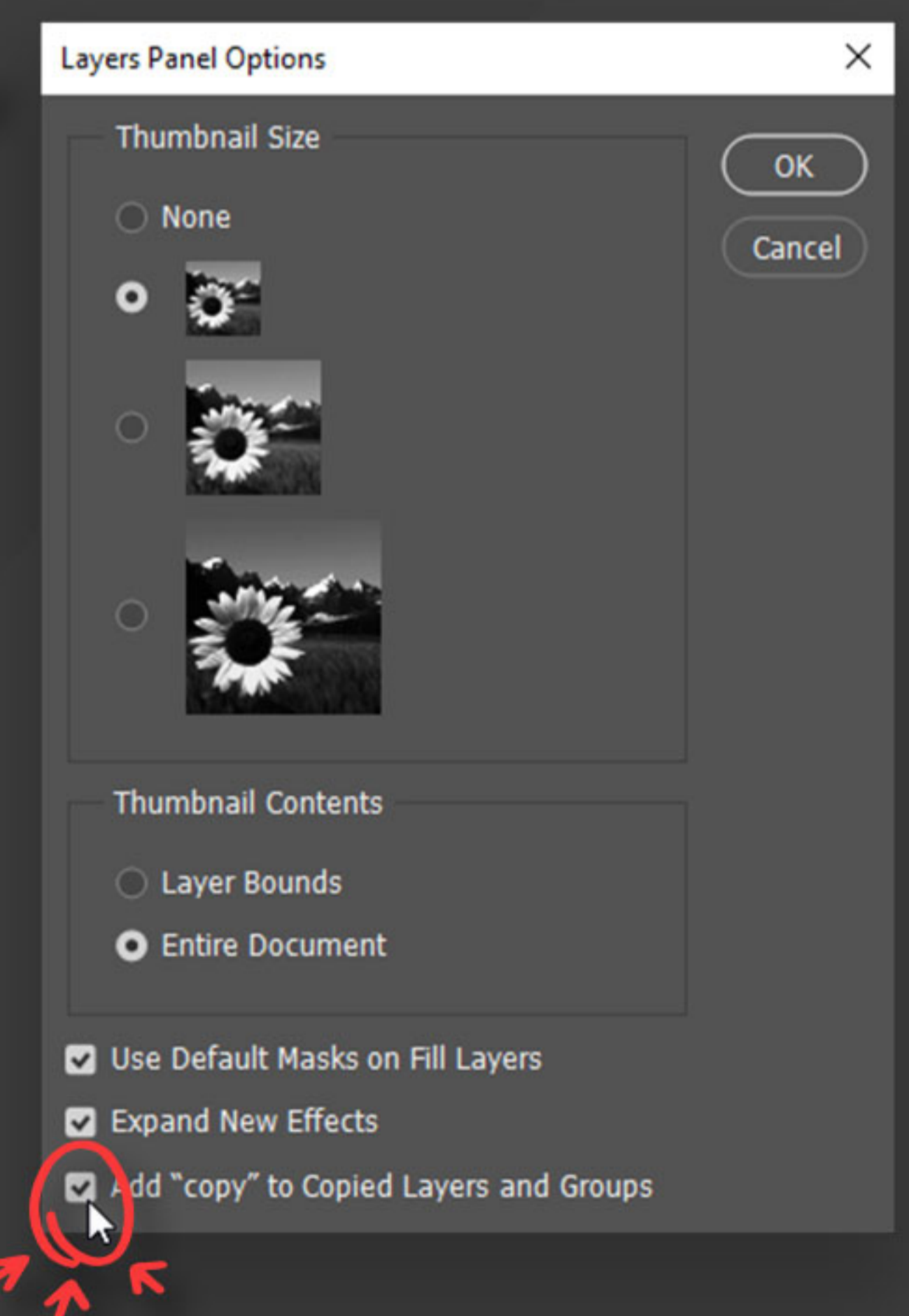
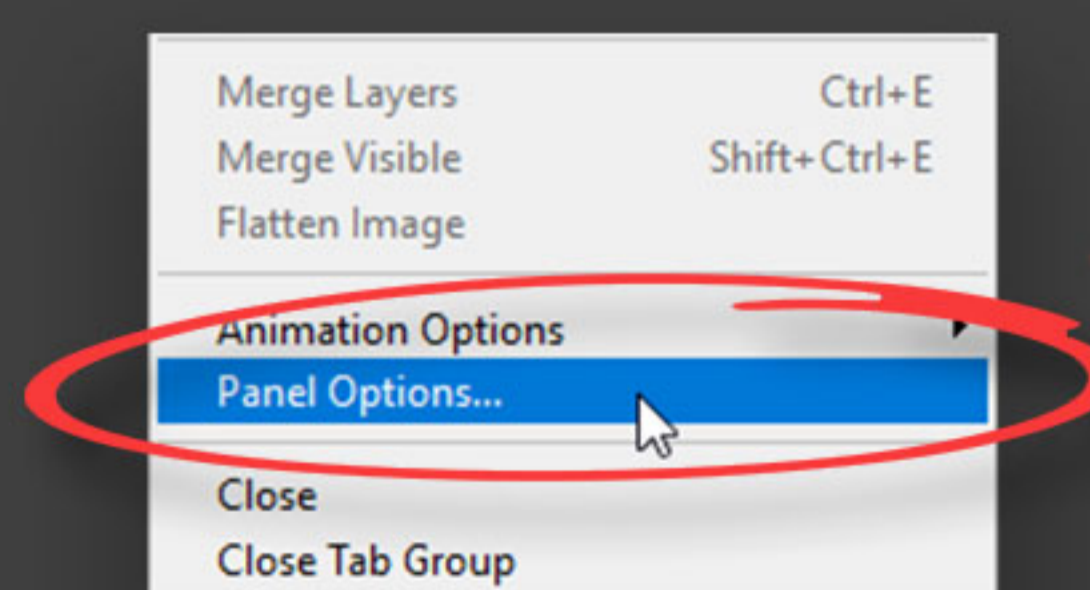
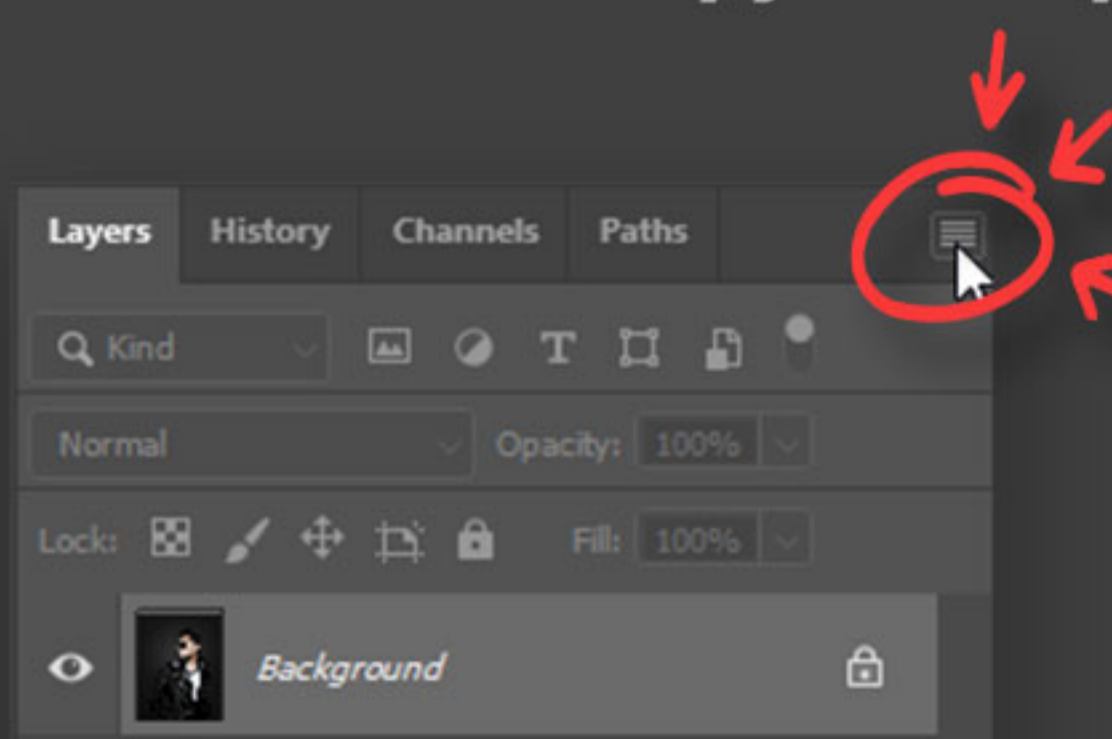
2. Your photo/image is must be in **RGB** color mode and **8bit** color mode to check and set RGB Color and 8bit color go to menu "**Image -> Mode -> RGB Color**" "**Image -> Mode -> 8 Bits/Channel**"



3. Make sure that the **image's layer is locked** and it's set as '**Background**'. to set a layer as Background go to menu: in the layer box, select the layer that you want to make as locked background, then select the menu tab "**Layer -> New -> Layer from Background**"



4. Click on menu icon at the right on "**Layers**" box panel and go to "**Panel Options**", and then check the "**Add "copy" to Copied Layers and Groups**"



5. Avoid using small or too large image resolution. For the best results, please refer to the instructions for setting up the use of stock images in "**IMAGE USAGE SETTINGS.jpg**".

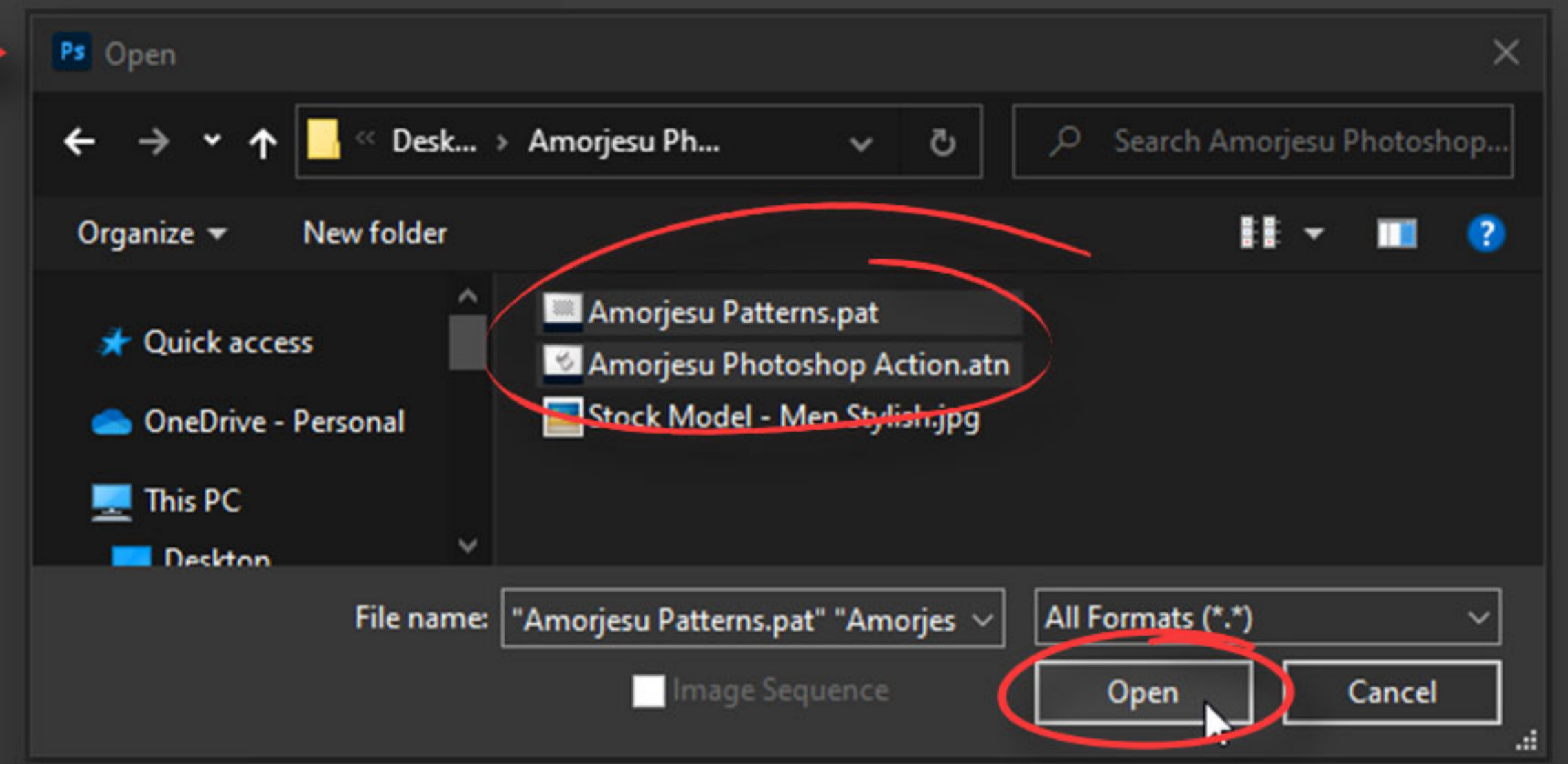
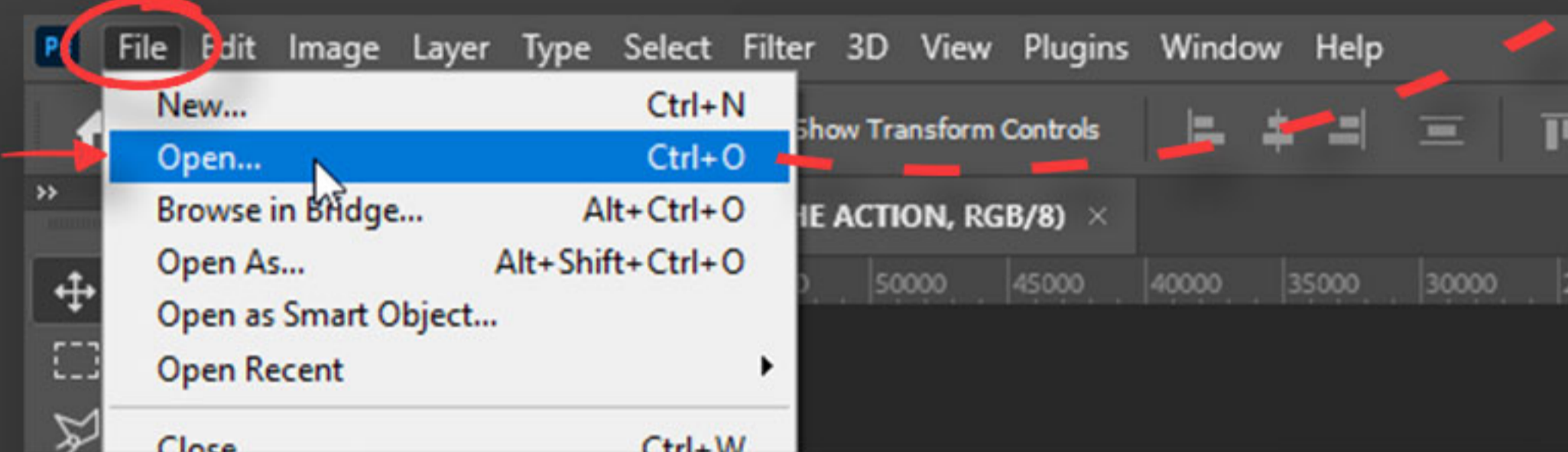
HOW TO USE THE ACTION

Please follow the instruction below

1. Import patterns and actions

Select **"File -> Open -> Choose a pattern and action you want to import"**

2. Check the availability of patterns and actions that have been imported

Pattern: Select **"Window -> Patterns -> In the Patterns box check the availability of the Pattern you just imported"**

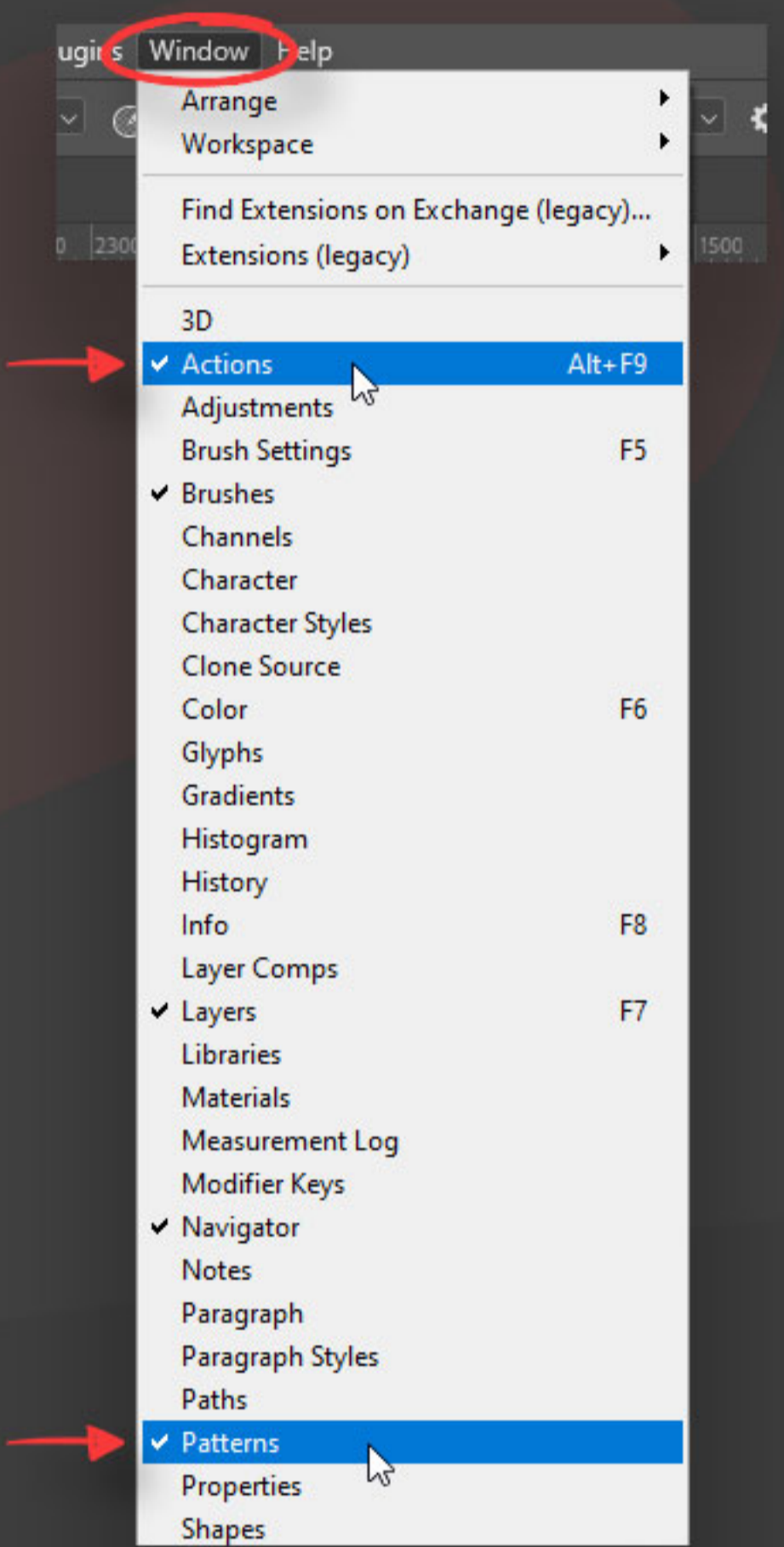
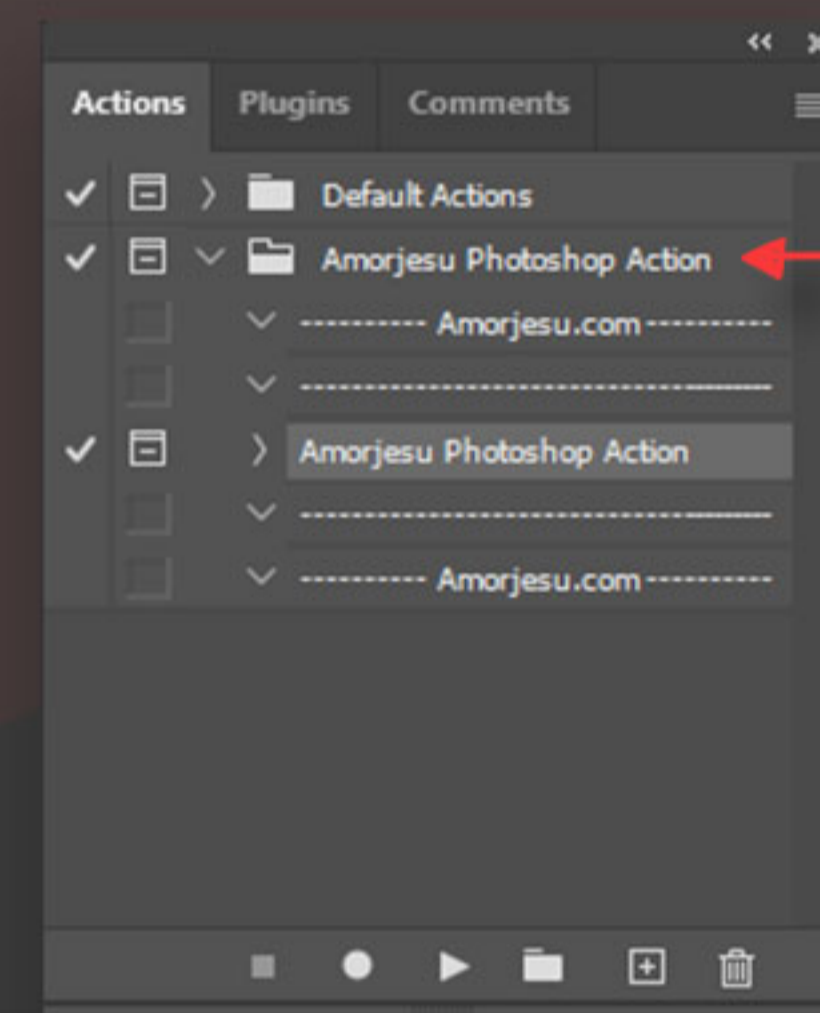
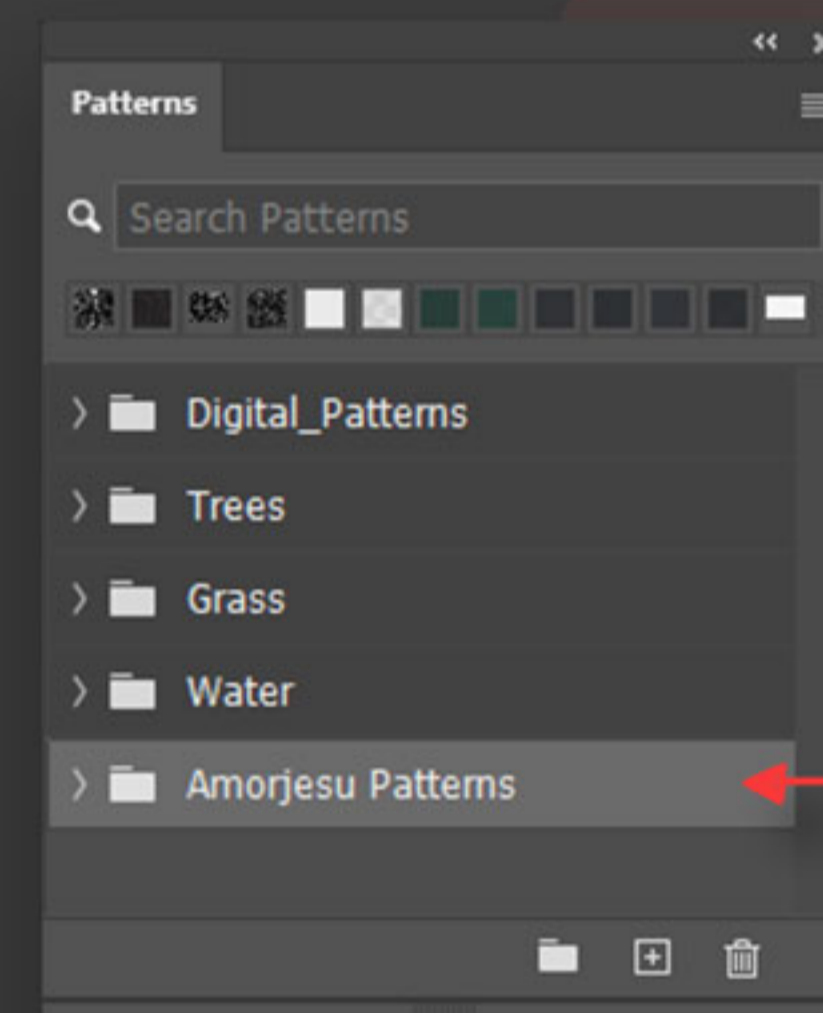
Action: Select **"Window -> Actions -> In the Actions box check the availability of the Action you just imported"**

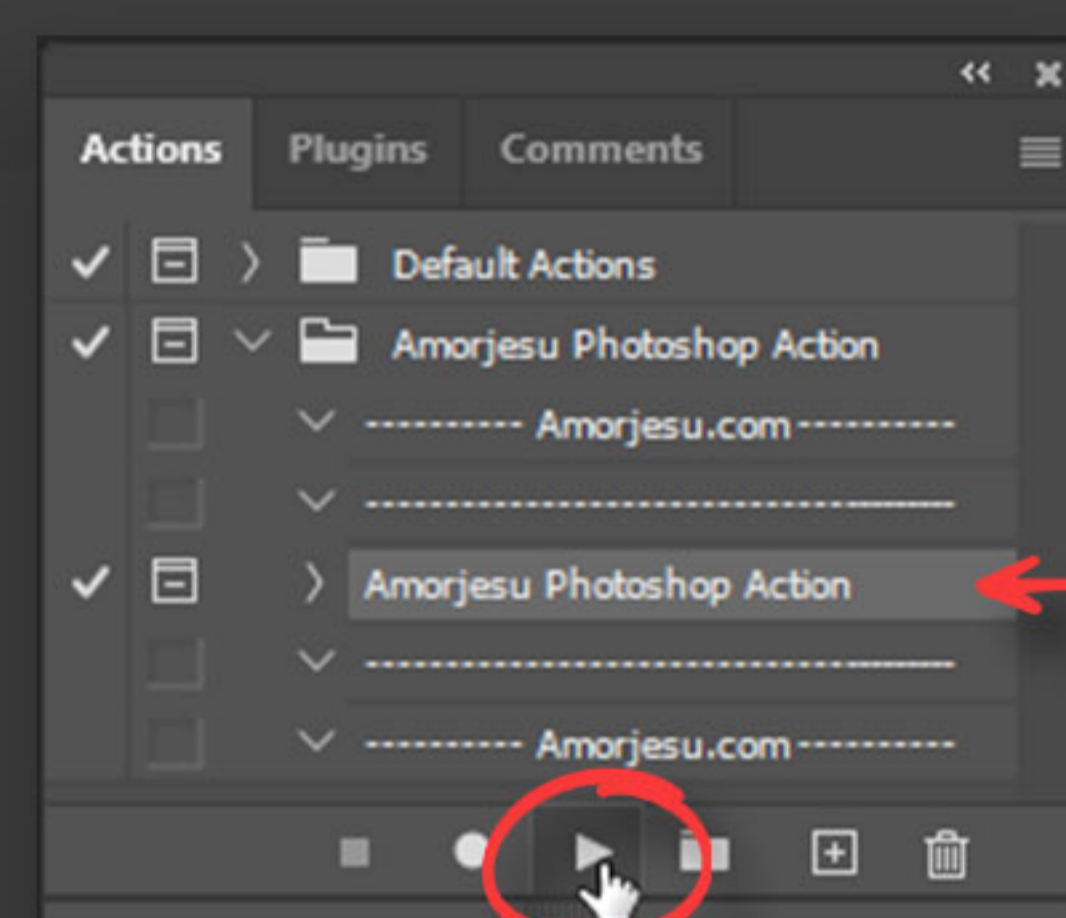
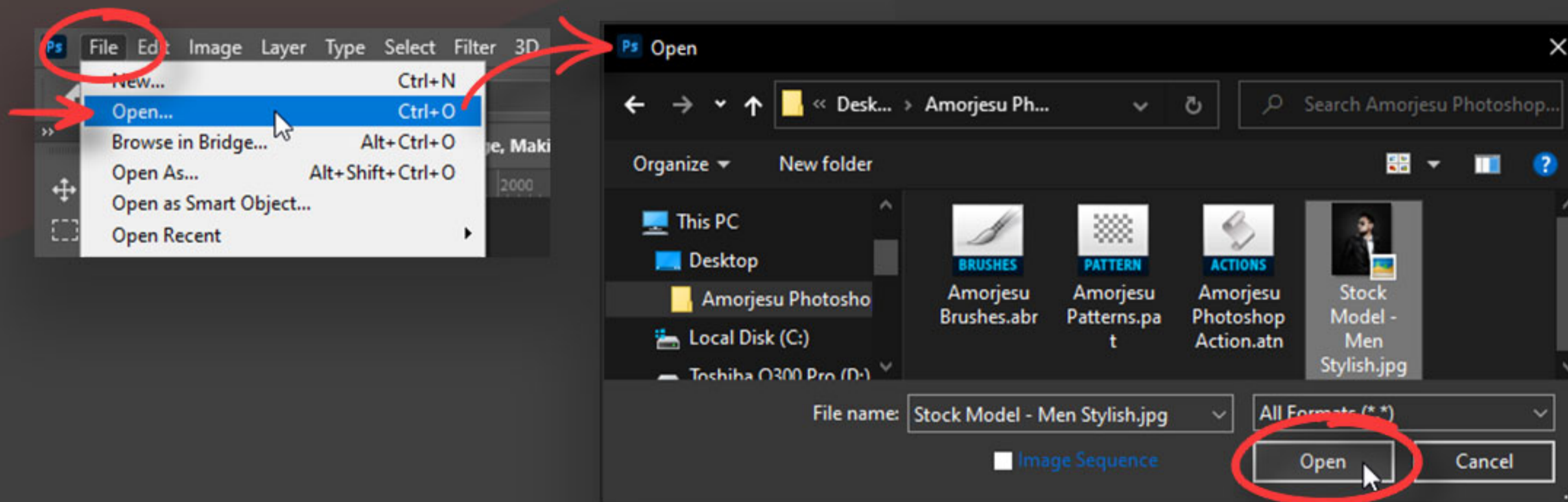


3. Open Image & Play Action

a. Open your image/photo:

Select **"File -> Open -> Choose a Image/photo you want to use"**.

b. In the Actions box select the action you want to use then press the "Play" button.



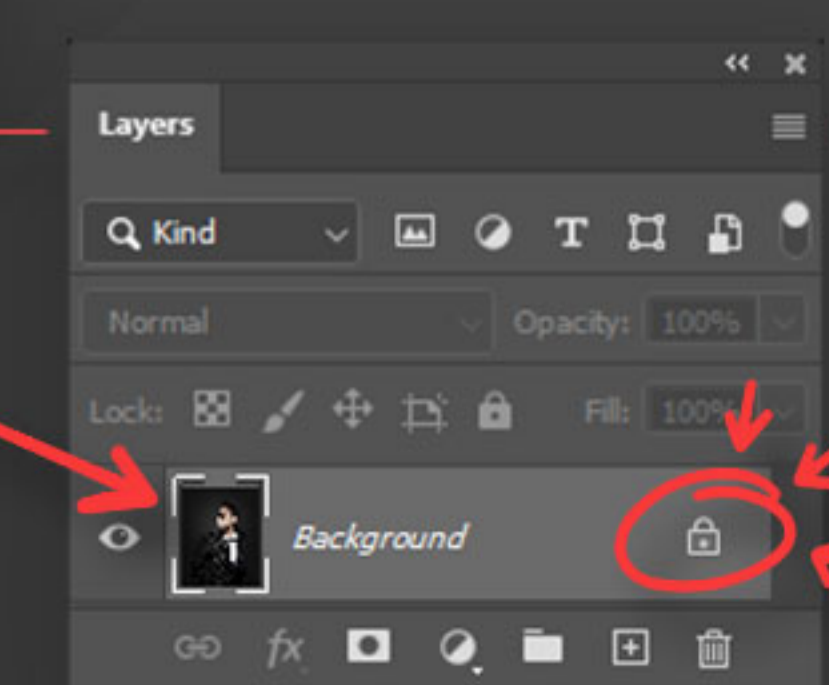
4. Wait a few seconds until the program finishes work

(speed of action work depends of the power of your computer).

5. And after all the process is completed, and the design you feel ready, please save your design.



Make sure the image layer is **locked** and it's set as **'Background'** (see: page 1 **"PREPARATION, IMPORTANT!!"** point 3).



TROUBLESHOOTING

If the action does not work properly or fails to run it is usually due to several things:

- use of different photoshop versions
 - often install or load plugins, action, brush, pattern
 - there have been several different settings
 - or it could be because of other problems
- try some of the ways below to solve your problem:

1. Check and change photoshop version
